



Volunteer Week Small Grants

National Volunteer Week, 12 - 18 May 2014

To acknowledge the efforts of volunteers in the Victor Harbor community, the City of Victor Harbor is offering small grants to encourage, and assist, non-profit community groups, management committees and organizing committees to celebrate and recognise the contribution of their volunteers.

Guidelines

Grants can be used to fund a range of “thankyou” celebrations that recognize the important contribution of volunteers to the Victor Harbor community. Activities can include things such as a morning tea, a lunch, certificates of appreciation, a barbeque, or small gift.

Celebrations will need to be held during National Volunteer Week, which will be 12 – 18 May 2014.

Eligible community groups do not need to be based in Victor Harbor, however, only activities that recognise volunteers that support the Victor Harbor community will be eligible for funding.

Two sizes of grants are available - \$50 for community groups with up to 15 volunteers, and \$100 for groups with more than 15 volunteers.

In assessing applications for funding, consideration will be given to the number of volunteers involved, and if the community organisation is making a financial, or in-kind contribution to the activity.

Applications

Successful and unsuccessful applicants will be advised in writing in early April. Grants funds will be provided to successful applicants by end April/ early May 2014.
