

2018 Schoolies Festival

Temporary Road Closure Notice

The 2018 Schoolies Festival will occur from 23 to 25 November 2018 in the areas surrounding Warland Reserve, Victor Harbor.

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 33(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Act 1961 that the following roads within the vicinity of the 2018 Schoolies Festival be declared temporarily closed to traffic at various times from Friday 23 November until Monday 26 November 2018 as specified below:

Friday 23 November – Sunday 25 November

- **Flinders Parade, Victor Harbor** from Coral Street to Esplanade from 5pm to 6am daily
- **Esplanade, Victor Harbor** from Flinders Parade to King Street from 5pm to 6am daily
- **Albert Place, Victor Harbor** from Esplanade to Crozier Road from 5pm to 6am daily
- **Railway Terrace, Victor Harbor** from Albert Place to Coral Street from 5pm to 6am daily
- **Ocean Street, Victor Harbor** from Coral Street to Albert Place from 5pm to 6am daily

Friday 23 November – Monday 26 November

- **Three Gullies Road, Encounter Bay** from Battye Road to Southern Right Crescent from 9am on 23 November to 8am on 26 November.

Exemptions have been granted for Council vehicles, emergency services, and vehicles owned by the property owners and/or residents that live on the closed section of Three Gullies Road.

Please be advised that the South Australian Police have approved 25 kph speed restrictions to be implemented around the festival site, while Council will implement a series of Temporary Parking Controls in conjunction with road closures.

Designated Dry Zone

An alteration to the dry zone area has been proclaimed during the 2018 Schoolies Festival under the Liquor Licensing (Dry Areas – Short Term) Variation Regulations 2012. The dry area will be effective from 8am on Monday 19 November to 10am on Monday 26 November 2018.

The consumption of alcohol will be prohibited, as identified, in the map (**shaded areas**) below.



The prohibition will extend to all public areas and footpaths, and will also include **Granite Island and the Causeway**.
