Have been granted approval to use a Council cat cage for the purpose of seizing feral/unidentified cat/s within the area of the City of Victor Harbor, and to have these cat/s disposed of at the expense of Council, subject to the conditions listed below, and provisions of the Dog & Cat Management Act 1995.

I further declare the following to be true:

1. I am 18 years of age or over.
2. I have read and understand the **Conditions of Use** as listed below and agree to abide by these conditions.
3. I myself or persons with whom I am associated with are in no way responsible for the cat/s.
4. I agree to pay the required \$50.00 deposit for the cage and further agree to pay any cost relating to the loss or damage of the cage while in my care.

Conditions of Use

1. That the appropriate application has been made and approved by Council.
2. Before setting the cage, neighbours within the vicinity, particularly residents known to have cats, must be advised.
3. ANY CAT SEIZED WITH A LETTER "M" TATTOOED IN ITS EAR, OR WEARING A COLLAR OR TAG WITH AN ADDRESS OR TELEPHONE NUMBER, MUST BE RELEASED IMMEDIATELY.
4. Council's nominated veterinary surgeon is only authorised to euthanize and dispose of feral/unidentified cats.
5. **No cat seized is to be held for a period longer than 12 hours. Consequently, no attempts to seize any cat are to be made more than 12 hours before normal working hours and operation of the veterinary surgeon.**
6. **This means no trapping on a Friday or Saturday night or the night before a public holiday.**
7. **No cat/s seized in a Council cage are to be taken directly to any veterinary surgeon within the Victor Harbor area.**
8. You are required to telephone Council on 85510500 by no later than 9.30am the following morning to arrange collection of the cat by a Council Officer. Council will take the cat to the veterinary surgeon.
9. Any cat seized must be humanely dealt with and actions taken to minimise the stress to the animal, including the provision of reasonable protection from the elements.
10. If you do not seize any cats during the hire period you must return the cage to the Council offices in sound and clean condition.
11. The first week of hire is free, subsequent weeks or part thereof will incur a cost of \$20.00.
