The Hindmarsh River Walking Trails

There is a choice of 5 trails in a series of loops which offer a variety of scenery, points of interest and distance.

The Waggon Trail crosses the Hindmarsh River and continues via Waggon Road and Yalladoola Road around the edge of the Victor Harbor Primary School to the school bridge. You should allow 1 hour to complete this trail.

The Wattle Trail commences at the Victor Harbor Primary School Bridge and follows the Hindmarsh River. You should allow 1 hour to complete this trail.

The McCracken Trail follows the Hindmarsh River to McCracken Playground and Picnic area. You should allow 1 hour return.

The Paperbark Trail is a loop which crosses the Victor Harbor Primary School Bridge, through a re-vegetated floodplain and back over the main roadway to Bridge Terrace. You should allow 30 minutes to 1 hour return.

The Lagoon Trail takes you through the beautiful paperbark woodland, over a series of boardwalks and around the lagoon. This lagoon is a remnant of what was once the route of the river. This walk is relatively easy and you should allow 20 to 30 minutes return.
